Planning your wedding can be a daunting task, which is why Dainty Bee Design has put together this information to help you plan your stationery, guest list and other essentials for your big day.

Before your wedding day

Tick all that you plan to include: **Engagement Party Invitation** If you decide to hold an engagement party, invites should be sent around two months before the event. They should include the location, date, time, and any required dress code. Save the Date Card Save the Date Cards aren't mandatory. Should you choose to send them out, they should be sent six to twelve months in advance. For weddings abroad, Save the Dates should be sent up to twelve months in advance. It is a courtesy that allows your guests enough time to plan and book their travel. Save the Dates should only be sent to guests who are invited to your whole wedding day, it can be very misleading and awkward if you send a Save the Date to an evening-only guest. Wedding Invitation The Wedding Invitation should be the largest and most substantial card in the invitation set. If your reception is happening at the same place, you usually do not need a Reception Invitation too. Wedding Invitations should be sent out around two to three months in advance. Reception Invitation If your reception will be at a different venue to the ceremony, you should include a Reception Invitation too. Anyone invited to your wedding ceremony should also be invited to your reception. A good rule of thumb is to invite colleagues and friends you see less often to your Reception. Reception Invitations should be sent out around two months in advance or along with the Wedding Invitations. R.S.V.P. Card R.S.V.P. Cards or Response Cards are a way to collect information about who is coming to your wedding, and who cannot make it. R.S.V.P. Cards can include the chosen meal options of your guests. Collecting R.S.V.P.'s via email or text message is also a popular option. R.S.V.P. Cards should be sent out with your Wedding Invitations. Menu Cards Menu Cards give an overview of what will be served for the meal. Some will include options of meals to choose from, while others will simply include the food on offer if you are serving a buffet style meal. Menu cards should be sent out with the Wedding Invitation. **Belly Bands** Belly Bands are an optional extra which are placed around your invites. They are not necessary, but they do look pretty whilst keeping all of your invitations together.
